Military Classification and Subclassification Testing Policies, Directions, and Other Information for the AFCT, DLPT, DLAB and CDC (Fire)

The Base Education Center on MCB Hawaii tests all active duty, reservists and qualified individuals frequently throughout the year. If you have any questions, please contact the MCBH Education Center.

- Testing Location: All testing is conducted at BLDG 220 (as of 13 April 2026)

### **Before Making an Appointment:**

- To register, you must be pre-approved for testing. If you are unsure whether you qualify or how to obtain approval, please contact the MCBH Education Center.
- Before signing up, confirm your availability on the scheduled date and ensure you have received Command approval if required. Do not reserve a spot unless you plan to attend and note that scheduling multiple appointments for the same test is not permitted.
- For any scheduling or test related questions not addressed on the MyEducation portal, please contact the MCBH Education Center directly.

### **On the Day of your Appointment:**

- Per MCO 1230.5C, all testers must be in the uniform of the day and have their CAC with them. Civilian attire is not permitted, regardless of leave status.
- Please arrive early to allow time for check-in and registration. All testing security policies will be strictly enforced.
- Electronic devices are strictly prohibited during testing and breaks. This includes, but is not limited to, cell phones, smart watches, and smart glasses. Any tester found with an electronic device will have their test immediately terminated and will be reported to the appropriate authorities – no exceptions.
- There are no authorized breaks for the DLAB or AFCT tests. A water bottle will be allowed while testing any exam.
  - DLPT tests only: All other food and drinks must be in sealed containers and may only be consumed during authorized breaks. Restroom use is also permitted during breaks. Per security policy, discussing exam content at any time is strictly prohibited.
- Once you have completed your test, the test administrator will provide instructions on your next steps before you are dismissed.

### **Test Results:**

- AFCT: Results will be posted to your MOL within 2-4 weeks. If you need further assistance, contact your S-1. The Education Center has no access to these results.
- CDC (Fire): Results can be seen immediately upon completion of the test.
- DLPT/DLAB: Most test results are available immediately upon completion and will be reflected in MOL within 2-4 weeks.

### **Directions to BLDG 220:**

Directions From the Main Gate (driving in from the H-3):

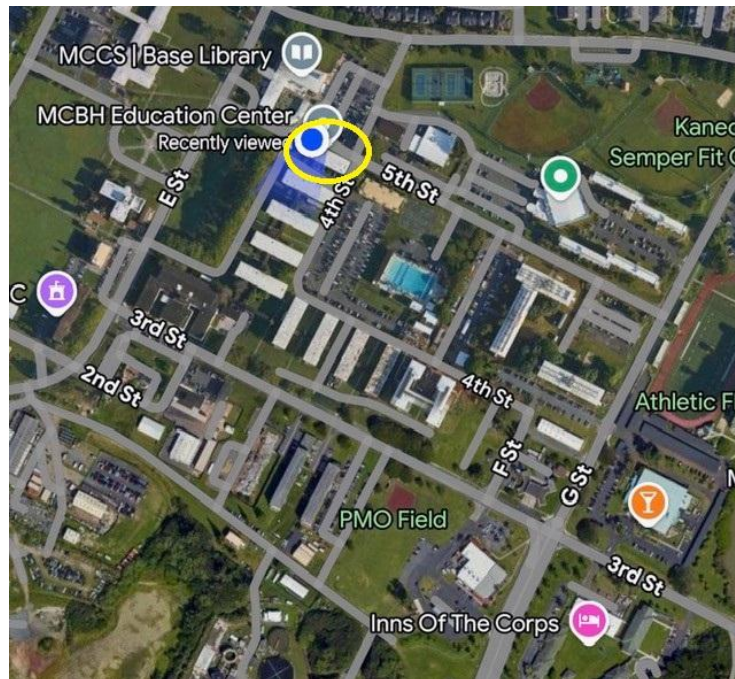
- Continue on G street until you make a left at 3rd St. Continue on 3rd St. until you see the Education Center on your left (there is a big, red arch in front of the building). The main parking lot will be located across from the Education Center, on your right. Additional parking is available behind the Education Center.

Directions From the Back Gate (driving in from Kailua)

- Continue straight on Mokapu Rd. Turn left at the stop sign immediately right after the tennis courts. Once you turn left, you can park in the main parking lot on your right or find additional parking behind the Education Center.
